Anyone who has ever moved knows what a challenge it is.

Host Richardt and his team were not discouraged and hurried in all directions. The path led from the painting business to the furniture store with the children's chairs to the flooring specialist. There was often hectic rush and confusion at first because the right contact persons were not on site, but everything went smoothly very

quickly.
